
- Initiated by the Prime Ministers of BSR countries in 1996

- Cooperation with EU neighbouring countries, incl. Russia & Belarus













Climate Change Adaptation Strategy and Action Plan for the BSR

- EU funded project Baltadapt (EUSBSR flagship)
- 3 Policy Fora 2012 2013
- Stakeholder dialogues: Tourism & Agriculture
- Presentation of final proposal: 3 September 2013
- Follow-up work 2013 2014:
 - EUSBSR Annual Forum
 - Climate Change Adaptation Forum in the Baltic Sea Region







Climate Change Adaptation strategy for the BSR

Strategy: Provide goals and visions. Clarifies links to other strategies and added value in a multilevel governance perspective "what in it for me". Identifies coordinators and implementers. Provides the "rules of the game" regarding exposure, impact and vulnerabilities to climate change.







Baltic Green Public Procurement, Baltic GPP

- 2 years project funed by EU BSR Programme 2007 2013
- National and international trainers seminar on GPP in BSR
- Estalishment of GPP focal points/ national help desks in project partner countries, SE, FI, NO, DK and DE
- Online seminar and training programme for procurers and suppliers, free of charge
- Good cases collection on GPP from the region as online publication in English
- Dissemination of project results to Russia and Baltic States (workshops)
- Translation of online publications into Russian
- Project extension until December 2013
- New project proposal Sustainable Public Procurement





EFFECT Dialogue Platform on Energy & Resource Efficiency in the BSR

- 11 partners from SE, RU, LT, BY, and PL
- Funded by Swedish Institute Thematic Partnership funding scheme
- Kick-off in November 2012 in Stockholm, Sweden
- Project duration 2012 2015
- Expected results:
 - Extension of the project parntership and (at least one) new project application to larger funding source (also investment projects)
 - definition of a holistic approach to "low carbon economy" in terms of energy/ resource efficiency as well as eco efficiency within "innovative Energy Transformation" processes
 - Factors of successful transformation of post-industrial to low-carbon societies





Bioenergy Promotion

- Funded by EU BSR Programme, 2009 2011 & 2012 2013
- Development of indicators system and strategies for deployment of sustainable bioenergy
- Development of strategic management plans
- Establishment of practical demo-regions
- Promotion of sustainable use and production of bioenergy for the BSR
- Lessons learnt catalogues for policy makers, practitioners and planners;
- Transfer of strategic management into demo regions
- Policy recommendations to MSPs and funding programmes 2014 2020
- Establishment of public and private utility companies





Next steps

- Follow-up on implementation of Rio+20 outcome document & its implications and status of implementation for EUSBSR MS
- Analysis on the state of play of SD in BSR, transnational gaps and challenges & added value of cross-border cooperation in BSR
- Development of SD indicators, targets and alternative SD measures, beyond BNP
- Linking up to the EU Strategy on Sustainable Development (ESDN-Observer)
- Continuation of Climate Change Adaptation Forum in the Baltic Sea Region ("Time to Baltadapt")
- HASD Kick-off at 4th EUSBSR Annual Forum 11-12 November 2013 in Vilnius, Lithuania
- Generation of new flagship project REALS, BUF
- HASD management, monitoring, TA-application
